Current ARIN Activities

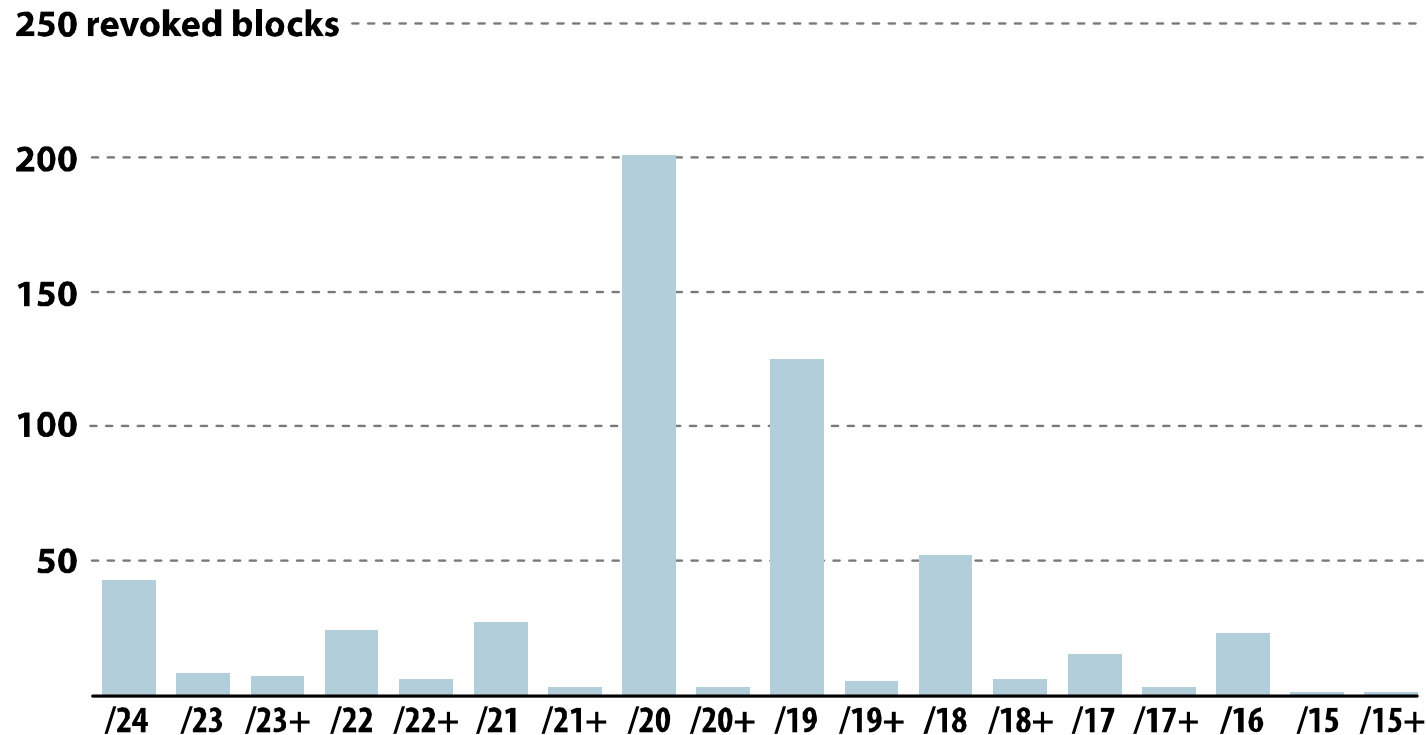
- ARIN Online 2.1 released
 - All Point of Contact (POC) maintenance can be done using a web account
- Community consultation underway
 - End use of templates for registration services
- Upcoming ARIN Elections
 - Board of Trustees (3 seats)
 - Advisory Council (5 seats)
 - NRO Number Council (1 seat)

Current ARIN Activities

- Research contracted:
 - Potential market pricing for IPv4 address space in the period near and through IPv4 exhaustion
- Developed an ARIN Pandemic Response Plan
- Supporting NRO efforts: ITU Telecom World this week, IGF in Nov.

Revoked Resources

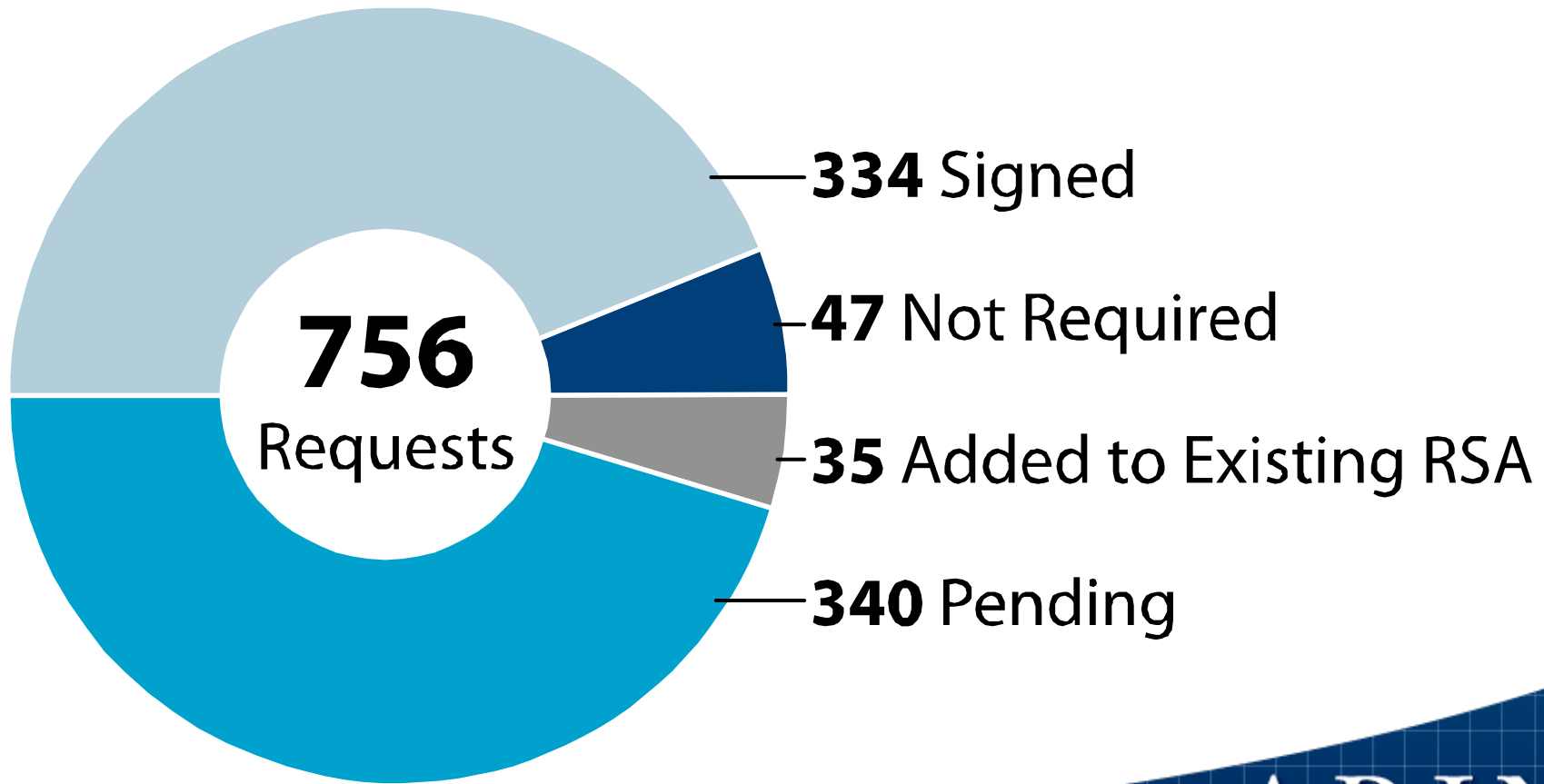
- Increased focus on overdue accounts
 - 3,852 ASNs revoked
 - 533 IPv4 blocks (totaling 84.3 /16s – breakdown below)
