What happened during RIPE 58

- Proposal text Phase 1 in RIPE:
 - Each RIR through their respective chosen policies and strategies may recover IPv4 address space which is under their administration.
 - Each RIR shall at quarterly intervals return any such recovered address space to the IANA in aggregated blocks of /24 or larger, for inclusion in the recovered IPv4 pool.



What happened during RIPE 58

- ARIN discussed different text edited by ARIN AC
 - Return to IANA only mandatory for legacy space
- RIPF 58:
 - Go with the ARIN version
- BUT then:
 - ARIN version revised and changed again

ARIN new version

- Each RIR through their respective chosen policies and strategies may:
 - recover IPv4 address space which is under their administration
 - designate any such space for return to the IANA.
- Each RIR shall at quarterly intervals return any such designated address space to the IANA in aggregated blocks of /24 or larger, for inclusion in the recovered IPv4 pool.



RIPE version

- Each RIR through their respective chosen policies and strategies may recover IPv4 address space which is under their administration.
- Each RIR shall at quarterly intervals return any such recovered address space to the IANA in aggregated blocks of /24 or larger, for inclusion in the recovered IPv4 pool.

RIPE Network Coordination Centre

Mainly...

- ARIN version
 - Return to IANA is optional for any space recovered
- RIPF version
 - Return to IANA is mandatory for any space recovered
