

Critical Internet Resources Workshops

- **Ipv6 - What you need to know.**
 - With most estimates predicting IPv4 addresses running out within the next two years, adoption of IPv6 has been slower than initial expectations, which may have consequences for business, government and End Users around the world.
 - This workshop will look at the implications of IPv4 exhaustion and the challenges of IPv6 deployment.
 - The workshop will also look at the leadership roles that government and the wider business community can play to ensure industry readiness for IPv6, and ways to promote IPv6 from a public policy viewpoint, with an aim to fostering greater international understanding and cooperation.



NRO response to Paragraph 76 Consultation

- Impact of the IGF
 - Various technical bodies, including the NRO, have used the IGF events to reach out and address much of the confusion and misunderstanding that exists in the areas of IP addressing, DNS and root servers.
 - Another positive impact has been the improved involvement of government and other stakeholders in Regional Internet Registry (RIR) policy development process.



NRO response to Paragraph 76 Consultation

- Is continuation desirable?
 - There remain barriers and issues to be addressed if the ideal of multi-stakeholder policy dialogue laid out in the Tunis Agenda is to be achieved.
 - The NRO advocates continued IGF focus on community issues, such as equal access and development, where collaboration by all parties involved is vital to finding a positive way forward.



NRO response to Paragraph 76 Consultation

- Possible improvements
 - The IGF is a valuable resource in assisting participants as they make decisions in their own respective organizations and jurisdictions, but the IGF should have no decision-making role of its own.
 - Further development of on-line discussions and remote participation in face-to-face meetings should also be prioritized as a means of encouraging wider participation.

- Conclusions

- The IGF must continue to stress the need for all stakeholders to work together in ensuring the continued growth, security, and stability of the Internet.
- The Internet's quick growth, and adaptability, is a direct result of its many stakeholders being able to contribute meaningfully to the dynamic processes of Internet policy creation and discussion.
- Multistakeholder engagement with the processes and structures of Internet governance, as facilitated by the IGF, is vital to the ongoing growth and innovation in the Internet community.
